Music is a wonderful gift from God. There are many different facets to understanding and developing this gift. At Holy Cross Lutheran Academy, our music classes are structured to help each student learn about how music is produced and how to develop their own musical talent.

Participation is essential to learning music. In addition to occasional homework and written class work, students need to participate in making music during class.

Grades earned during Music Class are determined as follows:

- ❖ Daily Class Grade – 10 points (as follows)
 - 3 points for coming to class prepared – bring Music Folder, pencil/eraser, and instrument/homework (if applicable)
 - 4 points for Participation – pay attention, attempt to answer questions, participate in musical exercises and songs
 - 3 points for Behavior – raise hand to share in class, be respectful of others, respond appropriately when called upon
- ❖ Homework – if assigned – points determined by degree of difficulty
 - Partial credit can be earned for late assignments. Every effort should be made to turn in assignments on time.
- ❖ Class work – if assigned – points determined by degree of difficulty
